1. Arrival in Pagedal 4th April

The keys of the accommodation / bungalows are available from 14:00 at the information desk (near the stairs in the central hall of the main building).

2. Early arrival

For teams who want to arrive earlier than on 4th April, arrangements can be made. The extra costs must be borne by the team. Please contact Pagedal at booking@pagedal.nl.

3. Registration Participants

The registration of the participants, the verification of the licenses, and the distribution of race numbers, frame numbers, transponders, and other materials and documents will take place on Tuesday, 4th April from 17:00 until 18:15 in Pagedal, on the first floor of the main building.

4. Team Managers Meeting

The Team Managers Meeting will be held on Tuesday, 4th April at 18:30 in Pagedal, on the first floor of the main building.

5. Transponders

During the Healthy Ageing Tour transponders will be used for the electronic identification of the riders. Dutch riders will be expected to use their own KNWU-registered transponder, whereas foreign riders will be provided with a transponder by the organization. The transponders will be distributed to the team manager at the registration of the teams. The transponders must be returned after the last stage in the permanence in Finsterwolde. For missing transponders the team will be charged for € 100. Note that the transponders must be used also on the time trial bikes during the Prologue, stage 1.

6. Radio Frequency

Race information will be broadcast on the following frequency: 155.9375.

7. Signing Attendance List

Every day all riders have to sign the attendance list at the ceremony truck before the start of the stage.

8. Television

During all stages television recordings will be made. A summary will be broadcasted during the live broadcast of the Elite races at the Podium.tv channel, and on internet www.healthyageingtour.nl, www.podium.tv, and www.dvhn.nl.

9. Results

The results will be published on the website www.healthyageingtour.nl, immediately after each stage. Moreover, the results will be sent by email to the team managers. For the Prologue, live results will be published at www.cyclingonline.info.

A hardcopy will be put in the team's pigeon hole in Pagedal, near the information desk, before dinner time. The package also includes the order of the team manager's cars in the next stage, plus the tracking numbers for the cars.



10. Environment.

A clean environment is important and essential for the organization of the Energiewacht Tour. As such, we make an urgent call to the riders, team managers, service personnel and all other attendance in the race, not to dispose garbage or materials on public roads, verges and ditches.

11. Parking at Pagedal

Please use the parking lots at Pagedal for your team cars, vans and buses. Parking on the grass is strictly forbidden! Only on Tuesday, the arrival day, cars are allowed near the bungalows in order to deliver the luggage. From Wednesday the roads on the park will be closed for cars until departure day.

12. Information Desk

During the event, there will be an information desk in the central hall at Het Pagedal; it will be opened daily during breakfast and dinner times. Riders and accompanying officials are welcome with all questions about the race and the accommodation. We like to help you!
